

Bring back Gosford Council



We, as residents of the former Gosford Council Local Government Area, are initiating this proposal to alter the boundaries of the Central Coast Council and reinstate the former Gosford Council under Sections 215 and 218E (2) of the Local Government Act 1993.

We are making this proposal to the NSW Local Government Minister because:

- The forced amalgamation of Gosford and Wyong Councils was undemocratic and deeply unwanted by the local community
- Gosford Council provided essential local representation as well as environmental protections for its residents
- Gosford Council was financially robust and very capable of managing its own financial affairs, and
- An overwhelming majority of Gosford residents preferred to retain their local council than see it swallowed up in a mega-merger with Wyong

We, as enrolled electors in the area that was the former Gosford Council, propose that:

- The boundaries of the Central Coast Council be altered so that the area that was the former Gosford Council prior to 12 May 2016 be excised
- The former Gosford Council be re-constituted within the boundaries it held before its amalgamation on 12 May 2016.
