

Bring back Holroyd Council



We, as residents of the former Holroyd Council Local Government Area, are initiating this proposal to alter the boundaries of the City of Parramatta and Cumberland councils and reinstate the former Holroyd under Sections 215 and 218E (2) of the Local Government Act 1993.

We are making this proposal to the NSW Local Government Minister because:

- The forced amalgamation of Parramatta City, The Hills Shire, Auburn City, Holroyd City and Hornsby Shire councils was undemocratic and deeply unwanted by the local community
- Holroyd Council provided essential local representation as well as environmental protections for its residents
- Holroyd Council was financially robust and very capable of managing its own financial affairs, and
- An overwhelming majority of Holroyd residents preferred to retain their local council than see it split up into two amalgamated mega-councils

We, as enrolled electors in the area that was the former Holroyd Council, propose that:

- The boundaries of the City of Parramatta and Cumberland Councils be altered so that the area that was the former Holroyd Council prior to 12 May 2016 be excised
- The former Holroyd Council be re-constituted within the boundaries it held before its amalgamation on 12 May 2016.
